



## **COVID19 MATCHDAY PROTOCOLS**

### **PRE-MATCH**

- Access to pitch will be via one-way system of Leisure Centre unless otherwise directed
- Social distancing guidelines must be obeyed until kick off
- Changing rooms will be open for use, maximum of 5 people at any one time, ideally teams should arrive ready to play
- Hand Sanitiser will be available
- Teams will be responsible for their own equipment and are expected to sanitise accordingly
- Players should bring their own individual water bottles
- Social distancing must be observed during warm ups. Warm ups should take place off of the pitch, in the half behind the corresponding dugout
- All team talks and tactical info must be delivered on the pitch including at the half time break
- Goal posts to be wiped down pre and post-match and at half time

### **MATCH**

- No Respect Handshake
- Kit and Boot checks to be carried out by officials on the pitch
- Coaching staff only in Dugouts remaining socially distant
- Substitutes should maintain social distancing; seating can be provided if required
- No spitting
- Goal celebrations should be avoided
- Interactions with the Referee and Assistants must observe social distancing

### **POST-MATCH**

- Government mandated social distancing guidelines must be followed at all times after the final whistle
- Depart following traffic flow system
- If you will be using the bar after the game, please note that bar service is waitress only. Do not stand at the bar, please wait at your table to be served.
- There will be no post-match hospitality

### **SPECTATORS**

- Follow the Leisure Centre traffic flow system through the bar area to the ticket booth
- Please follow social distancing guidelines should you need to queue at the ticket booth or for refreshments
- Cash will be accepted, please try to ensure that you have the correct change
- You will need to check in to the Track and Trace scheme, if you are unable to follow the online check in, please provide your contact details to a member of the team

- Please observe social distancing at all times, supporters should spread around the pitch perimeter
- Fewer seats will be available within the stand, please respect that some are reserved for visiting officials
- Please refrain from holding the pitch side railings
- If the match ball leaves the playing area, you must not use your hands to return it
- Shouting and singing are discouraged
- Toilets are located upstairs in the leisure centre, please follow the directions
- Please bring your own sanitiser or use sanitising stations around the centre regularly
- If you are using the bar, please note that bar service is waitress only. Do not stand at the bar, please wait at your table to be served

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
