Spread of Covid-19 during DLCFC Club gatherings.	Anyone in close proximity to other people, including members of the public (DLCFC pitch is an area open to the public); members of DLC staff, public users of the DLC and paying spectators.	<p>Everyone in attendance at any gathering organised by DLCFC is expected to adhere to the Government's guidelines on preventing the spread of Covid-19. In addition to these guidelines, the following controls shall be observed:</p> <p>Spectators shall follow all clearly-marked signage on their journey from the car park to the pitch-side, which will ensure compliance with Government guidelines.</p> <p>DLCFC shall provide adequate hand sanitiser and signage at appropriate points along this journey, together with additional hand sanitiser stations at various locations outside.</p> <p>All doors between the car park are either automatic or wedged-open to ensure that no contact with hard surfaces is necessary between the car park and pitch-side.</p> <p>Spectators shall be expected to follow the well-established Government guidelines with regard to their social distancing while on the premises, including during visits to the bar area and toilet facilities.</p> <p>Seating in the grandstand shall be duly cordoned-off/marked as appropriate to ensure spectators are clear on necessary spacings.</p>	<p>Where social distancing is not possible and/or practicable, e.g. for administration of treatment following an injury, then the person giving treatment shall wear a mask.</p> <p>Warm-ups and team talks to be held outside and away from the opposition team.</p> <p>The Manager or session organiser shall remove any participant who does not adhere to the FA and Government rules and guidelines.</p>	All	Now	

		<p>Players shall attend a mandatory safety briefing held by the Manager or his deputy prior to commencing a training session or match. Attendees of each safety briefing shall be logged.</p> <p>The purpose of the safety briefing is to educate and inform players of their expectations and responsibilities.</p> <p>COVID-19 Self-Assessment/Check Prior to any training session or match, participants shall perform a COVID-19 Self-Assessment/Check. If a participant has any symptoms detailed below then they MUST NOT attend:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- A new continuous cough.- Shortness of breath.- A sore throat.- Loss of or a change of normal sense of taste and smell.- Feeling generally unwell.- Persistent tiredness.- Been in close contact or living with somebody who is suspected or has tested positive for COVID-19. <p>The Manager must remind and communicate to players/parents/guardians the need to conduct a COVID-19 Self-Assessment/Check before every training session and/or match.</p> <p>Players should arrive to matches already in their kit and make provisions to ensure it is properly laundered and available for the next session.</p>

		<p>Car sharing to travel to and from training session and games should be minimised. If car sharing must occur, ensure suitable PPE is used and disinfect vehicle where necessary after use. Players are encouraged to cycle or run to games where reasonably possible.</p> <p>Changing rooms should not be used (exceptions to be made in certain circumstances as outlined in the FA guidelines - in this situation, the changing rooms shall be used in strict adherence to Government guidelines).</p> <p>Any additional rules or directives on display within the DLC or advised by members of DLC staff should also be observed.</p> <p>Minimise the amount of time players are in close proximity to each other for extended periods of time (e.g. marking on corner/free kick training).</p> <p>The Manager shall plan regular hygiene breaks within the session to sanitise hands and equipment.</p> <p>Learn from previous sessions - apply any changes necessary to improve the safety of the session based on previous experience.</p>
